

CLIFFS OF MOHER TOUR


The iconic Cliffs of Moher are one of **Ireland's natural masterpieces** and geological wonders. The staggering height of these vertical rock faces rise to 700 ft before abruptly falling away into the deep waters of the Atlantic Ocean. The surrounding landscape is a marvel of natural delights, with delicate sea campion, blushing sea pinks and wildflowers dotting the springy coastal grass around your feet. On a calm day, keep an eye out for ripples in the water as basking sharks and friendly dolphin pods are a common sight. It is no wonder this area was awarded a **UNESCO Geopark site. Climb O'Brien's Tower** a lookout point built in the 19th century by the local landlord Cornelius O'Brien where you can enjoy unrivalled views of the surrounding seascape. Afterwards enjoy a seafood feast in a local restaurant before heading back to Galway city.

TRADITIONAL MUSICAL PUB CRAWL

Explore Irish culture in the heart of Galway city, the group could do a **Musical Pub Crawl**. Our Irish Musical Pub Crawl is led by **two professional musicians** who perform tunes and songs while **telling the story of Irish music** and its influences on contemporary world music. Your guests will meet with the musicians at the hotel lobby where they will be split into smaller groups and led to various **local pubs in Galway City**. The hosts will **chat, charm and entertain** your guests on route to the pub. On arrival there will be an area reserved in each pub for your guests to sit and listen to the musicians play, sing songs and tell stories of Ireland and Irish Music while **enjoying a Guinness** or two and some food along the way. Best described as an "**interactive moving concert**", the show brings the group to three pubs.







This bustling and lively city with its wonderful avant-garde culture has a fascinating history which you can enjoy during your walking tour of the city's historic quarters. While the city has many relics of its medieval past it has changed considerably over the last number of years and features a fascinating juxtaposition of new and ancient architecture. Your walking tour will take you to the remains of the 16th century Spanish Arch, an extension of the famous city walls, a remainder of Galway's former merchant trade with Spain, whose galleons often docked under its protection. There will be a visit to St. Nicholas's Church, founded in 1320, and dedicated, like many other European churches in seaports, to Saint Nicholas of Myra, the patron saint of seafarers. Local legend states that Christopher Columbus worshipped there when he visited the city in 1477.

Enjoy lunch in one of Galway's great restaurants. There is time after lunch to ramble around the city on your own. Happily, the city is conveniently compact making it easy to explore its eclectic mixture of locally owned specialty shops.
